

Direction 2016-002

The Director of Civil Aviation for Jersey (DCA), in exercise of his powers under Article 47 of the Air Navigation (Jersey) Law 2014, hereby makes the following directions by reason of the intended holding of the Jersey International Air Display 2016:

- (1) Subject to paragraph (3), between the hours of –
 - (a) 1245 and 1700 hours on Wednesday, September 7th 2016; and
 - (b) 1145 and 1600 hours on Thursday, September 8th 2016,an aircraft shall not fly within so much of the restricted airspace mentioned in paragraph (2).
- (2) The restricted airspace referred to in paragraph (1) is the airspace from the surface to flight level 120 within the area bounded by the circumference of a circle having a radius of 6 nautical miles centred at display datum 49°11'18.7"N 002°07'57.4"W.
- (3) The restriction specified in paragraph (1) shall not apply to –
 - (a) any aircraft flying with the permission of the Senior Air Traffic Controller Jersey;
 - (b) air traffic flying under the control of Jersey ATC;
 - (c) any aircraft flying for the purpose of search and rescue or for the purpose of saving life;
 - (d) any aircraft flying in the Jersey International Air Display or in practices for that air display, flying with the permission of the flying display director for that air display.
- (4) In paragraph (1) all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

Contravention of any part of these directions is an offence under Article 155 of the Air Navigation (Jersey) Law 2014.
