

Prohibition of flying - Jersey International Air Display 2017

In order to ensure the safety of participants and other air traffic during the above event, the Director of Civil Aviation, in exercise of his powers in Jersey¹ hereby prohibits the operation of small unmanned aircraft (SUAs - colloquially known as “drones”). This direction is effective at the following times:

1. from 1300 BST until 1800 BST on Wednesday, September 13th, 2017, and
2. from 1200 BST until 1800 BST on Thursday, September 14th, 2017.

This order is effective throughout the island of Jersey and up to three nautical miles offshore.

This restriction does not apply to:

1. Holders of a current Aviation Permit for commercial SUA operations who have obtained permission for their flights from Jersey air traffic control.

Contravention of this direction is an offence².

A similar restriction is also in place in Guernsey for the air display on that island.
